(light the second candle - Peace)

One: Jesus said, "My Peace I leave with you."

All: Let peace begin with me.

One: The third Advent Candle is Guadete, "rejoice" or Joy.

(light the third candle - Joy)

One: Joy is a sacred gift from the Lord.

All: May we always give thanks to the Lord for Joy, for happiness.

One: Today we light the fourth Advent Candle, the Candle of Love. (*light the fourth candle - Love*)

One: "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten son."

All: "Now faith, hope, and love abide, these three; and the greatest of these is love."
